# 2024 Selection criteria:

- Boys and Girls 3,4, and 5.
- All Level-8 overall skiers, plus the top 2 level-8 skiers in slalom, trick and jump from each qualifying age group.
  - Up to 4 discretionary spots for Girls-2 and Boys-2
    - Participation at Regionals or Nationals.

Team members are invited to attend one of two three-day Western Region Best of the West Water Ski Development Camps. Team members are coached by professional, high-level coaches. Camps are being scheduled for June in California and Washington.






