- Boys and Girls 3,4, and 5.
- All Level-8 overall skiers, plus the top 2 level-8 skiers in slalom, trick and jump from each qualifying age group.
- Up to 4 discretionary spots for Girls-2 and Boys-2 demonstrating extraordinary potential.
  - Participation at Regionals or Nationals

Team members are invited to attend a three-day Western Region Best of the West Water Ski Development Camp. Team members are coached by professional, high-level coaches. The camp is scheduled for June 8-10. If space is available, alternates will be invited to the BotW camp. Additional "area camps" are planned throughout the region and are open to all junior skiers.




